At York Hospital's Oncology & Infusion Care, we offer access to hundreds of clinical trials for cancer patients through our affiliation with the Eastern Cooperative Oncology Group (ECOG) and Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center in Boston and our membership in the National Cancer Institute's Clinical Trials Support Unit (CTSU).

Infusion Therapy

We also offer a variety of individualized infusion therapy services, including a range of IV treatments such as IV antibiotic therapy, anticoagulant injections, blood transfusions and treatments for a variety of conditions including Rheumatoid Arthritis, Crohn's Disease and Osteoporosis.
