Testing Instructions

- Treadmill Stress Test
- Treadmill Stress Echo

- ***Do not take the following medications for 24 hours before your test, unless otherwise instructed by your doctor.***

Acebutolol, Atenolol, Betapace, Betaxolol, Betopic, Bisoprolol, Blocadren, Cartrol, Carteolol, Carvedilol, Coreg, Corgard, CorzideInderal, Inderal LA, Inderide, Inderide LA, Kerlone, Labetalol, Levobunolol, Levatol, Lopressor, Lopressor HCT, Metipranolol, Metoprolol, Nadolol, Normodyne, Ocupress, Penbutolol, Pindolol, Propanolol, Sectral, Sotalol, Tenormin, Tenoretic, Timolide, Timotol, Toprol XL, Trandate, Visken, Zebeta, Ziac

- Wear comfortable walking shoes or sneakers and pants. - you will be walking on the treadmill as part of your test.
- Eat lightly two hours before your test, nothing to eat after that.
- Avoid caffeine before your test.

- T-Wave Alternans

- Wear comfortable walking shoes or sneakers and pants – you will be walking on the treadmill as part of your test.
- Check with your physician regarding your medications.

- Echocardiogram
- Venous Duplex Scan
- Arterial Duplex Scan
- Carotid Ultrasound
- Holter Monitor
- EKG
- Ankle Brachial Index

- There is no preparation for these tests.

- Transesophageal Echo

- ***Eat lightly 8 hours before your test, nothing to eat or drink after that.***
- Take all routine medications with a sip of water.
- An IV will be started before your test.
- You will be receiving light sedation during your test so you will need someone to drive you home.

- Tilt Table Test

- ***Do not have anything to eat or drink after midnight.***
- Take your morning medications with a sip of water unless otherwise instructed by your doctor.
- Do not take Diabetes medication on the morning of your test.
- An IV will be started before your test.

- AAA Screen
- AAA Complete

- ***Do not eat after midnight.*** You can have something to drink (coffee, tea, juice, water). Avoid dairy.
- Take your morning medications.
