

Dear Friends,


We have so much to be thankful for this past year, including everyone reading this report. I am honored to share York Hospital's first Philanthropic Impact Report with you. In 2024, some key initiatives included:

- Launch of the \$6.4M *Leading with Heart* Cardiac Campaign to build a new Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory. With your help, we have raised over \$5,942,000 in donations and private foundation, state and federal grant support. We continue to raise funds for this lifesaving project and remain grateful for your support.
- Annual giving totalled \$295,135 in 2024, supporting programs that strengthen staff and benefit patients.

As we reflect, we are also reminded of the generosity of donors who have passed on, and whose bequests continue to support our work through York Hospital's Loving Kindness Legacy Program.

Caring for All Fund

The year began on a strong note with a generous donation from **Coca-Cola Beverages Northeast** to York Hospital's Caring for All Fund. Among other critical projects, the Fund helped us acquire a new C-Arm for the Surgery Center. This Fluoroscopy system provides real-time X-ray imaging, which is particularly useful for guiding various diagnostic and interventional procedures during surgery.

In 2024, Caring for All funds also supported treatment and recovery services for people affected by substance use disorders. The Fund also made possible upgrades to our Information Technology secure data systems (servers, routers, switches, and other networking equipment).

\$6.4M Leading with Heart Cardiac Campaign

In January 2024, we launched the quiet phase of our *Leading with Heart* Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory Campaign. Thanks to our generous and caring community of donors, York Hospital raised over \$5.9 million by December 31, reaching 93% fulfillment of our \$6.4 million campaign goal. We are pleased to announce the **Petrovich Peterson Cardiac Catheterization Lab**, named in honor of Dr. Lawrence Petrovich and his 40 years of service as a cardiologist at York Hospital, and in deep appreciation of the Peterson family's philanthropic commitment to the hospital's non-profit mission.

Diana Baldwin Dunnan Fund for Nursing Excellence at York Hospital

This initiative allows York Hospital to offer an extraordinary hands-on education for our newest nursing staff members through the New Graduate Nurse Residency Program. The Rev. Dr. D. Stuart Dunnan says: "The Baldwin Family has been supporting York Hospital for generations, beginning with our grandparents Donald and Winifred Baldwin. Nursing was a particular passion of our grandmother's, and my mother Diana Baldwin Dunnan continued this support through her lifetime, so we now honor her as well."

In 2024, the fund trained new graduate nurses to ensure that they are skilled in providing top quality care in both inpatient and outpatient settings at York Hospital, including ICU, Med/Surg, Cardiology and Emergency Departments. If you were seen at York Hospital last year, chances are the altruism of the Baldwin and Dunnan Families enriched your visit.

The Hancock Family Fund for Healthy Aging

The Hancock Family Fund supports the York Hospital Center for Older Adults, enabling us to provide vital transportation services for patients to and from medical appointments, and home prescription deliveries. In 2024, we provided 9,299 rides to seniors needing medical care, an increase of 7.39% over 2023. We also delivered 969 prescriptions to individuals unable to leave their homes.

York Teams Playing for a Cause: The Living Well With Cancer Fund

In 2024, two York teams donated tournament proceeds to the York Hospital Living Well With Cancer Fund. The **York Paddle & Pickleball Club** and the **York High School Boys Hockey Team** (pictured below) helped raise over \$5,000 to support the Living Well With Cancer Fund.

This fund provides resources such as wigs, recovery camisoles, gas cards, and heating assistance to help patients navigate their cancer journeys. The fund also provides physical, emotional, and spiritual support through post-operative massages, acupuncture, journaling classes, writer's workshops, and various art activities.
