AARP Foundation Tax-Aide Program to Assist Eligible Mainers in Receiving Pandemic Relief Payments

The AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program in Maine, which normally ends its annual tax preparation services in mid-April with the traditional IRS filing deadline, has extended its availability of its tax preparation services to assist people who haven't already filed a 2021 Maine individual income tax return.

What to Bring:

- Social Security card
- A picture ID
- Social Security benefits statement (SSA-1099)
- All other income-related tax documents for tax year 2021.
- Information on rents or property taxes paid in 2021

NOTE: The program will only be preparing Maine returns for those who did not file because they had no need to file (low income). The program will not be preparing full (federal/state) returns, prior year returns, amended returns, etc. Program volunteers are addressing a special need to have filed a Maine return in order to qualify for the \$850 pandemic relief payment, not extending their normal tax preparation services.
